- **Do you or someone you know have difficulty with reading, writing, or spelling?**
- **Does he or she find it hard staying on task, paying attention, or sitting still?**
- **Have you noticed difficulties with coordination and organisation or is socialising and communicating a problem?**

Any or all the above can make studying more challenging than it needs to be.



Our multidisciplinary team which includes psychologists and occupational therapists can provide assessment, support, and intervention for learners of any age with these kinds of difficulties. The Assessment Service offers support to individuals experiencing difficulties in specific areas of their learning.

People who have used the service include those who have experienced difficulties in the following areas:

- **Dyslexia**
- **Dyspraxia**
- **Asperger's Syndrome**
- **Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder**
- **Autism**
- **Study Skills**

You may have noticed that an employee working with you may also have some of these difficulties. However, with appropriate support individuals with specific learning difficulties can make valuable and considerable contributions to the workplace. Very often both the employer and the employee will benefit from implementing a simple strategy such as giving written as well as oral instructions, or by using a particular piece of technology or software.
